Abbreviations: **m** - mile; **N** - north; **E** -east; **S** - south; **W** - west. "~" means "about"

**It is recommended** that water sources be verified with local sources, such as Forest Service Ranger Stations, National Park Service, BLM offices, or AZA Trail Stewards. Water quality may vary greatly and it is recommend that water sources be treated to reduce risk of water borne diseases.
